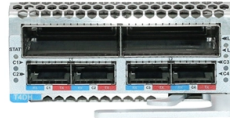

Gigabit Ethernet ONU: Focused on high-speed connectivity, ideal for business applications requiring fast data transfer. ONUs can also be categorized by deployment scenario: SFU/SBU (Single Family/Business Unit): Connects to a single user, often providing 1-2 POTS interfaces for voice services. HGU (Home Gateway Unit): Used in FTTH networks, typically includes multiple Ethernet ports, WLAN, and USB interfaces. MDU/MTU (Multi-Dwelling/Multi-Tenant Unit): Serves multiple users in FTTB/C networks, offering multiple Ethernet or DSL interfaces. Integration with Fiber Optic Panels ONUs are often mounted or connected via fiber optic panels, racks, or structured cabling systems. Fiber panels provide organized termination points for optical fibers, allowing ONUs to interface efficiently with the network. Panels may include splice trays, modules, and ports to manage multiple ONUs in residential or commercial deployments.
