- Installation versatility:** Terminal boxes can be installed in 19" racks, wall-mounted, or floor-mounted, and are suitable for both indoor and outdoor applications. Some advanced terminal boxes, such as Fiber Distribution Hubs (FDH), include splitters for FTTH (fiber-to-the-home) networks, allowing a single fiber to serve multiple endpoints.
