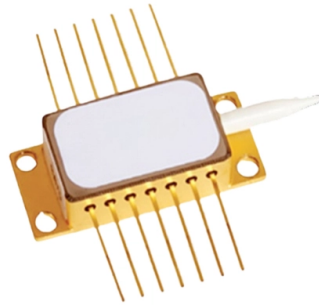

High humidity or condensation can create conductive paths on surfaces, increasing the risk of electrical tracking. For critical installations, consider automated environmental sensors to detect moisture or temperature extremes early .
4. Regular Visual Inspection and Cleaning Perform routine inspections to check for physical damage, dust accumulation, or signs of moisture. Clean the FTB using non-abrasive, anti-static cloths and approved cleaning solutions to prevent contamination that could compromise insulation or connectors . Inspect cable entry points and seals for wear or degradation.
