Terminal boxes can be mounted on walls, racks, DIN rails, or installed outdoors with weatherproof enclosures depending on the environment.

Tools and Materials Needed Fiber termination box or cabinet suitable for your environment (indoor/outdoor) Fiber optic cables and pigtails Fiber adapters (SC, LC, FC, ST) Cable cutters, strippers, and cleavers Splice trays and fusion splicer Labeling tape and markers Cleaning agents (alcohol or specialized fiber cleaner) Gloves to prevent contamination

Installation Steps

Site Preparation Confirm the type of box and its port capacity. Choose a mounting location that is accessible and protected from environmental hazards. Outdoor boxes should have UV resistance and IP65/IP68 protection.

Mounting the Box or Cabinet For wall-mounted boxes, ensure the front panel is easily accessible. For rack-mounted cabinets, use standard 19-inch racks. Secure the box firmly to prevent movement or vibration.

Cable Preparation Inspect fiber cables for damage. Strip the outer jacket carefully and clean the fibers. Pierce the rubber diaphragm at the cable entry point before inserting the cable.

Fiber Routing and Slack Management Route fibers through guide posts or transport tubes inside the box. Coil excess fiber neatly in splice trays to maintain bend radius and prevent entanglement.
