

Fiber Optic Terminal Box to Router

Install the Fiber Terminal Box (if not pre-installed): Choose a wall or cable rack location with at least 20 cm clearance for cable storage. Secure the terminal box using screws or appropriate mounting hardware. Insert the fiber optic cable into the terminal box and connect it to the designated port, ensuring the connector is clean and properly seated.

Connect Fiber Cable to ONT: Plug the fiber optic cable from the terminal box into the ONT's fiber input port. Ensure the connection is secure to avoid signal loss.

Power On the ONT: Connect the ONT to a power source and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2–5 minutes).

Link ONT to Router: Use a high-quality Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN port. For advanced setups, an SFP+ module may be used if supported.

Power On the Router: Wait for the router's indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Configure Router Settings: Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1) and enter ISP credentials if required. Enable Quality of Service (QoS) for VoIP or video calls if needed.
