Couplers often use ceramic ferrules to align fibers precisely, ensuring low insertion loss and high mechanical strength. Termination can be done via connectors (temporary joints) or splices (permanent joints). Singlemode fibers typically require factory-made pigtails or splice-on connectors for precise alignment, while multimode fibers can often be terminated directly in the field.
