- Maintain Bend Radius:** Fibers should follow the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer to prevent signal loss or breakage. Use the guides in the splice cassette to route fibers safely ().
- Organize Excess Fiber:** Store extra fiber length in loops within the splice cassette. This allows future re-splicing or connector changes without stressing the fibers ().
- Secure Cables:** Use cable ties or Velcro straps to gently bind fibers together. Avoid over-tightening, which can damage the fiber or increase attenuation ().
- Splicing Method:** Fusion splicing is preferred for permanent, low-loss connections ().
