

Fiber optic cable connection to ONU

How Fiber Connects to an ONU

The fiber optic cable carries data as pulses of light from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the service provider's central office through the Optical Distribution Network (ODN) to the ONU located near the user. The ODN includes several segments: feeder fiber, optical distribution points, distribution fiber, optical access points, and drop fiber. The ONU can also aggregate upstream data from multiple devices and send it back to the OLT, optimizing network efficiency.

Types of ONUs

ONUs are categorized based on deployment scenarios:

- SFU/SBU (Single Family/Business Unit):** Serves a single user, often in FTTH or FTTO networks, with a few Ethernet or POTS interfaces.
- HGU (Home Gateway Unit):** Common in FTTH, includes multiple Ethernet ports, WLAN, and USB interfaces.
- MDU/MTU (Multi-Dwelling/Multi-Tenant Unit):** Serves multiple users in FTTB/C networks, offering numerous Ethernet or DSL interfaces.

Installation Considerations

Fiber installation to an ONU requires careful planning to ensure signal quality. The fiber must be properly terminated with connectors, and the ONU should be positioned to minimize signal loss and allow easy access for maintenance. The ONU is typically installed inside the home, office, or building, depending on whether the network is FTTH, FTTB, or FTTN.
