Cleaning and Connector Care Maintaining cleanliness is critical. Dust, oil, and static electricity can cause signal reflection, insertion loss, or connector corrosion. Use anti-static vacuums for floors and cable channels, and clean patch panels and connector ends with professional tools like fiber optic end-face cleaning pens or lint-free wipes. Avoid household tissues or cotton swabs, as they can leave fibers behind. Isopropyl alcohol (99% pure) is recommended for cleaning, followed by dry wiping to remove residue. Environmental Control Temperature and humidity affect fiber performance. Maintain a stable environment (18–27°C, 40–60% relative humidity) to prevent micro-bending losses. Dust control through high-efficiency air filters and proper airflow planning is essential, especially in data centers with high-density cabling. Outdoor cables should be protected from moisture, tight bends, and physical stress. Safety and Operational Procedures Strict adherence to safety protocols is necessary. Always switch off signals before plugging or unplugging patch cords, avoid inspecting live optical ports, and...
