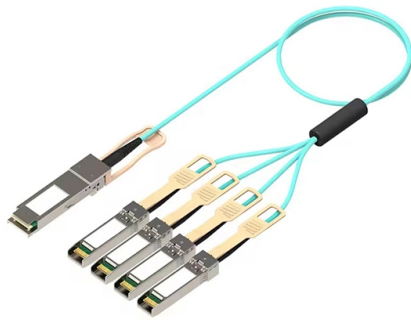


Fiber optic switch cannot connect to network

Verify Fiber Polarity Fiber links are full-duplex, requiring the Transmit (Tx) on one end to connect to the Receive (Rx) on the other. If Tx is connected to Tx or Rx to Rx, the link will remain down. Flipping one end of the duplex LC cable usually resolves polarity issues and restores connectivity. Test Transceivers and Ports Swap the SFPs with known-good units to rule out faulty transceivers. Perform a loopback test on the fiber port to confirm that the port itself is operational. Check the link status LEDs; a “LOS” (Loss of Signal) indicator signals connectivity problems. Review Configuration Ensure that the switch interfaces are correctly configured, with no IP conflicts or misconfigured VLANs. For multigigabit links, explicitly setting speed and duplex may be necessary. Rebooting the switch can sometimes resolve temporary glitches.
