- Tighten the lid properly:** Follow manufacturer torque specifications to ensure a uniform seal.
- Seal cable entries:** Use rated cable glands, plugs, or sealants designed for the box's IP/NEMA rating.
- Verify seal integrity:** Conduct visual inspections and, if possible, water or dust ingress tests before energizing the system.
- Regular maintenance:** Periodically inspect the box for wear, corrosion, or loose connections to maintain long-term reliability.
