Firestop Materials: Use firestop packs, mineral wool, intumescent caulks, or fire-resistant boards in an orderly sequence.

Support Plates: At slab penetrations, a fire-support plate is installed at the top to reinforce the seal.

Waterstop: For floor-level or slab penetrations, a minimum 50 mm waterstop is recommended.

Maintenance: Fireproof partitions should allow for easy addition or replacement of cables without compromising fire protection.

Performance Ratings: Fireproof partition plates and associated firestopping systems are often UL Listed or certified to meet 1–3 hour F-Ratings depending on wall or slab type. Ensure compliance with local fire codes and standards for industrial or commercial installations.
