- Enclosure/Housing:** The outer shell, usually made of SPCC steel or aluminum, provides structural support, EMI shielding, and environmental protection. It can be designed for indoor (dust-resistant) or outdoor (weatherproof) use, with adjustable mounting options for racks or cabinets.
- Fiber Splice Trays:** Removable trays inside the ODF protect spliced fibers from stress and contamination. They are often made of anti-static engineering plastics and can hold multiple splices (e.g., 12-24 per tray), with larger ODFs accommodating dozens of trays.
- Adapter Panels:** These panels hold fiber optic adapters (LC, SC, ST, MPO, etc.) that connect terminat...
