Outdoor Panels Outdoor fiber optic panels are built to withstand rain, snow, dust, and wind, typically made from fiberglass, steel, or aluminum . They are used for direct outdoor installations and protect fibers from environmental hazards.

DIN-Mounted Panels DIN-mounted panels are designed for industrial or specialized applications, allowing installation on DIN rails. They are less common but useful in constrained or modular setups .

Modular and Cassette-Based Panels Modular panels, such as FPX, MFPS, or high-density cassette panels, allow flexible configurations with adapter packs, splice cassettes, or preterminated pigtails . Cassette-based designs support seamless upgrades from 10G to 400G/800G networks without replacing the entire panel. These panels often include bend radius protection to prevent micro-bending losses and maintain optical performance .
