It organizes and protects fiber connections, allowing easy management, testing, and future expansion. Panels typically support: LC, SC, ST, or FC connectors for patch cords or jumpers; Splice trays for fusion splicing of fibers; PLC splitters for distributing signals in FTTH networks. Using a fiber panel ensures that your network is modular and scalable, making upgrades to 10G PON or multi-gig networks straightforward without replacing the entire cable plant.

Network Architecture Options

Most gigabit fiber networks use Passive Optical Network (PON) architectures, which are cost-effective and efficient for FTTH deployments. Key types include:

- GPON (Gigabit PON):** Provides 2.5 Gbps downstream and 1.25 Gbps upstream, shared among multiple users. Ideal for residential networks.
- XGS-PON:** Symmetrical 10 Gbps capacity, suitable for business or high-demand users.
- 25G PON:** Future-proof solution for enterprise, 5G, and smart city deployments.

These architectures allow multiple users to share a single fiber while maintaining high performance, and upgrades can often be done over the same fiber infrastructure.

Components for Deployment

To build a robust gigabit fiber network, you need:

- Fiber cables:** Indoor/outdoor OM3/OM4 multimode or OS2 single-mode cables for long-distance or high-speed applications.
