Wire Connection: Strip about three-quarters of an inch of insulation from the wire end. Form a loop (J-hook) around the grounding screw in the clockwise direction to ensure a secure mechanical connection.

Multiple Devices: In multi-gang boxes, use pigtails or ground clips to connect all devices to the main ground wire, avoiding congestion and ensuring continuity.

Ground Rod and Resistance Testing: Connect the ground wire to a buried grounding rod. Test the resistance using a voltmeter; the resistance should meet safety standards (commonly
