- Wire Sizing:** For long tool cables or multiple spindles, use larger cross-section wires (e.g., 16 mm² or 6 AWG in the US) to maintain low resistance.
- Connection Reliability:** Ensure all connections are tight, corrosion-free, and clearly marked for inspection and maintenance.
- Parallel Grounding:** Grounding points should be arranged in parallel rather than sequentially to prevent a single point of failure from compromising the system.

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
