Bonding Methods Flexible Connections: For moving parts like doors, flexible copper braided straps are recommended to maintain consistent contact and reduce resistance fluctuations. Anti-loosening washers help prevent mechanical loosening over time. Surface Preparation: Remove oxide layers or coatings at the contact points to ensure low contact resistance. Applying conductive paste can protect against moisture and oxidation, especially in outdoor or high-humidity environments.
