Future expansion: Choose a slightly taller cabinet if you anticipate adding more equipment later, which avoids costly replacements. Compatibility: Most cabinets follow the EIA-310 standard, ensuring a 19-inch internal width and standardized mounting hole spacing, so equipment from different manufacturers fits properly.
