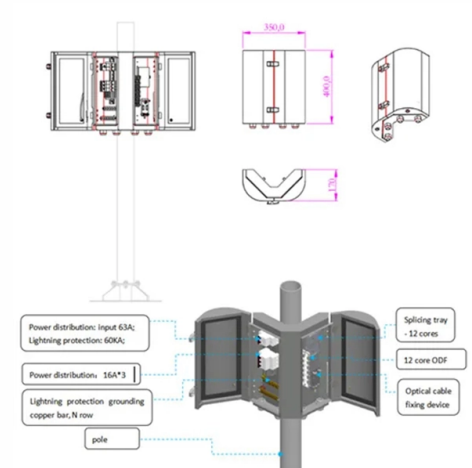


Height of the secondary distribution box switch
