Insulation and Shielding: Use stress cones, insulation tapes, or terminations to prevent partial discharge and maintain dielectric strength.

Grounding: Connect the box and cable shields to a reliable earth ground to prevent electrical hazards and ensure system stability.

Testing: Perform insulation resistance and continuity tests before energizing the system.
