In high-vibration environments, standard nuts and bolts may loosen over time, so locking hardware, vibration-damping pads, and closer support spacing are recommended to prevent metal fatigue and cable damage . Cable Management Cables should be secured within the tray using cable ties or clamps near connection points to reduce stress on the tray and prevent rubbing or abrasion . Maintain proper cable fill ratios (usually max 50%) to avoid overloading the tray and ensure adequate ventilation, especially for ladder-type trays . Grounding and Bonding A secure cable tray system must be properly grounded and bonded to the building's main earth system. Use bonding jumpers to electrically connect all tray sections, ensuring continuity and safety in case of electrical faults . Regularly inspect these connections to maintain effectiveness. Material Selection Choose tray materials based on environmental conditions. For corrosive or high-moisture areas, fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) trays offer corrosion resistance and non-conductivity .
