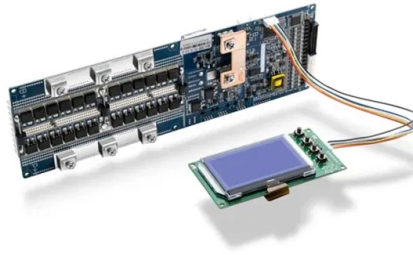


How far is the third-level distribution box from the ground

This height also aligns with NEC 110.26 headroom requirements, which specify a minimum of 2 meters (6 ft 6 in) of clearance above the floor for safe working space.

Horizontal and Branching Distances The horizontal distance between a tertiary switch box and the electrical equipment it controls should preferably not exceed 3 meters to minimize voltage drop and improve safety. The distance between a secondary distribution board and tertiary switch boxes should not exceed 30 meters to maintain proper hierarchical distribution and reduce energy loss.

Safety and Compliance Considerations Ensure that each switch box is equipped with a leakage protector and that parameters are matched for sensitivity and reliability. Maintain clear working space around the box for inspection, maintenance, and emergency access, following NEC and OSHA guidelines. Avoid bypassing levels in the distribution hierarchy to preserve system integrity and safety. By following these height and distance guidelines, tertiary distribution boxes can be installed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with standard electrical codes.
