- Hierarchical Distribution:** Level 3 boxes receive power from secondary distribution boards (level 2) and must not bypass the hierarchical structure.
- Separate Circuits for Power and Lighting:** If both lighting and power circuits are present, they should be distributed via separate breakers within the level 3 box.

- Future Expansion:** Leave space for additional breakers if more devices are expected.
- Load Calculation:** Ensure the total load does not exceed the box's rating...
