

# How many circuits should a household electrical distribution box have

**General-Purpose Circuits** General lighting and standard outlets throughout living spaces (bedrooms, living rooms, hallways) are served by general-purpose branch circuits. The number of these circuits is calculated based on the total lighting load, typically 3 VA per square foot, divided by the capacity of a standard 15- or 20-amp circuit.

**Panel Capacity and Future-Proofing**

**Panel size**: Most modern homes use a 200A service with a 42-space panel, which accommodates current needs and allows for 15-20% spare capacity for future additions like EV chargers, workshops, or home offices.

**Minimum panel spaces**: Never install fewer than 30 spaces, as this limits flexibility and future expansion.
