- Ribbon Cables:** Fibers are arranged in flat, ribbon-like structures, often in multiples of 12 or 24, enabling fast mass fusion splicing. These are used where large numbers of fibers need to be terminated efficiently.

2. Based on Installation Method

- GYTS (Gyta Type with Steel Wire Strength):** The most common outdoor cable, featuring a stranded loose-tube design with a central steel wire for tensile strength. Suitable for telecom backbones, metro access, FTTH feeder, and long-distance transmission. Can be installed in ducts, aerially with a messenger, or direct-burial with armor.
- ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting):** A premium aerial cable with no metal components, allowing installation on high-voltage power lines without electrical interference. Reinforced with aramid yarn and FRP rods for tensile strength.
