Check Physical Constraints Measure doorways, hallways, elevators, and ceiling height to ensure the cabinet can be transported to its installation site. Add 4–6 inches to account for shipping pallets and packaging. If space is limited, consider shorter cabinets, multiple cabinets, or flat-pack assemblies.

Standard Cabinet Heights Common cabinet heights include: 24–25U for cabinets around 1200 mm external height; 41–43U for cabinets around 2000 mm external height. A standard recommendation for general use is a 42U cabinet, balancing accessibility and future expansion.
