

How to arrange cables in a ladder-type cable tray

Bend Management:

When routing cables around bends, ensure gradual curves to avoid sharp bends that can damage insulation or reduce cable life.

Ventilation and Heat Dissipation:

The open design of ladder trays allows air circulation around cables, preventing overheating. Avoid stacking cables excessively, as this can reduce airflow and increase temperature.

Segregation of Cable Types:

Keep high-voltage power cables separate from low-voltage or data cables to minimize electromagnetic interference and maintain signal integrity.

Future Expansion:

Leave space for additional cables to accommodate future upgrades without overcrowding the tray.
