Optical Loss Test Set (OLTS): Injects a known light level at one end and measures received power at the other to calculate loss, detecting degradation.
OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer): Identifies faults, splices, and bends along the fiber.
- 4. Check Internet Speed**Perform a wired speed test to confirm gigabit performance. Use a reliable online tool and connect directly via Ethernet to the router. Fiber connections typically provide high symmetric speeds (upload and download), unlike cable connections. Ensure no other applications are...
