

How to check if a distribution box has multiple circuits

- 4. Verify Each Circuit** After mapping, turn each breaker back on and confirm that all devices on that circuit function correctly. This ensures that the breaker is properly controlling the intended area or equipment.
- 5. Label and Document** Once all circuits are identified, label each breaker clearly in the panel. Keep a copy of your circuit map near the distribution box for future reference or maintenance.
- 6. Optional Tools** For more complex systems, you can use circuit tracers or testers to identify circuits without turning off power to the entire panel. This is especially useful in commercial buildings or when multiple sub-panels exist.

Tips for Safety and Efficiency Always follow local electrical codes and safety standards. Leave space in the distribution box for future circuits or upgrades.
