

How to check the fiber optic cable model and specifications

Identify Fiber Type Singlemode (SMF): Typically 9 µm core, 125 µm cladding, used for long-distance, high-speed transmission. Common grades include OS1 (indoor) and OS2 (outdoor/long-range) (Fibercables Direct).

Multimode (MMF): Larger cores, e.g., 50/125 µm or 62.5/125 µm, used for shorter distances. Grades include OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5, with OM3/OM4 optimized for 10G/40G networks and OM5 for SWDM applications (Getek).

Understand Cable Model Codes Fiber optic cables often use model codes to indicate application, reinforcement, structure, and sheath type (ZRCable).

Classification code: e.g., GY = outdoor communication cable, GR = soft cable, GH = submarine cable.

Reinforcement member: F = non-metallic, G = metal heavy-duty.

Derived feature: D = ribbon fiber, B = flat, T = filled, Z = self-supporting.

Protective layer: Y = polyethylene, V = PVC, L = aluminum, G = steel.

Outer sheath: Numeric codes indicate armor or sleeve type. For example, GYGZL03 translates to outdoor cable (GY), metal heavy reinforcement (G), self-supporting (Z), aluminum sheath (L), poly...
