

How to configure circuits in a home electrical distribution box

Wire color coding: typically, blue for neutral, yellow/green/red for phases A, B, and C.

Cable Entry and Connections Cables usually enter from one direction (often above the panel). Remove knockouts starting with the largest cables and use appropriate connectors or bushings to protect insulation. Larger cables (#10AWG or #8AWG) fit one per connector; smaller household cables (#12AWG or #14AWG) can fit two per connector. Cut wires to length, strip ends, and bend toward the bus before connecting to streamline the process.

Labeling and Safety Label each cable at both ends with its circuit designation (e.g., "Kitchen A," "Bath B") to simplify future maintenance. Bind wires with plastic ties, keeping spacing uniform to maintain straight, organized runs...
