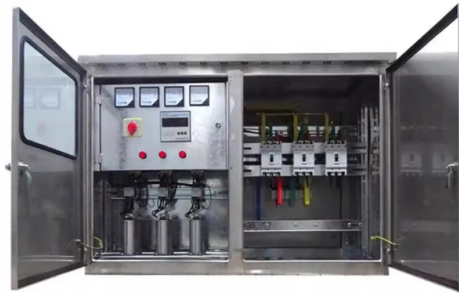


How to connect a low-voltage fiber optic terminal box
