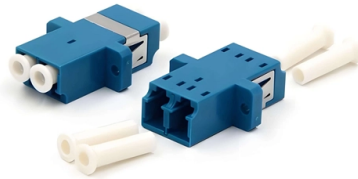


How to connect a network cable using a 24-core fiber optic cable

Ensure polarity alignment: MPO cables have specific fiber arrangements (A-to-B or straight-through) to match transmit and receive lanes ().

Step 4: Connect the Network Cable
The transceiver converts the optical signal to electrical, allowing you to plug in a standard Ethernet network cable to your switch, router, or server port. Verify that the transceiver type matches the network speed (e.g., 40G, 100G) and the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) ().

Step 5: Test and Manage the Connection
Use OTDRs or visual fault locators to check for breaks or misalignment (). Manage cables carefully to avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius and prevent signal degradation (). Secure excess fiber with velcro straps or cable managers to...
