

How to connect a telecom fiber optic router to fiber optic cable

Precautions

- Handle fiber connectors by the plastic housing to avoid damage.
- Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply, as this can degrade signal quality.
- Place the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets, ideally with surge protection.
