

How to connect network cables and fiber optic cables using a front panel

Connecting Network (Ethernet) Cables

Connecting Fiber Optic Cables

Use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or fiber-ready router: Fiber optic signals must be converted to electrical signals for standard networking equipment. The ONT provided by your ISP typically handles this conversion.

Select the correct fiber connector: Common types include SC/APC or SC/UPC. Ensure the front panel port or patch panel supports the connector type.

Route the fiber cable carefully: Fiber cables are fragile; avoid tight bends and kinks. Use cable management clips or trays to maintain proper bend radius.

Connect to the patch panel or ONT: Insert the fiber cable into the designated port on the patch panel or ONT. If using a patch panel, ensure the fiber is properly terminated and aligned to avoid signal loss.

Link to the router: If the ONT is separate, connect it to your router using an Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port.

Best Practices

Label cables: Clearly mark both Ethernet and fiber cables to simplify troubleshooting and maintenance.
