

How to connect the conductive flexible wire in the distribution box

Step 3: Attach the Connector

Slide the connector onto the conduit end. Tighten the screws or compression collar to secure the conduit firmly. Insert an insulating bushing inside the connector to protect wire insulation from sharp edges.

Step 4: Connect to the Distribution Box

Remove the appropriate knockout hole on the box using a screwdriver or punch. Insert the conduit connector through the knockout. From inside the box, thread a locknut onto the connector and tighten it to establish a secure mechanical and electrical bond. Ensure the conduit is seated firmly and the connection is stable.
