

How to connect the fiber optic cable box to the home

Step 3: Set Up the Optical Network Terminal (ONT)The ONT is the critical device that converts light signals from the fiber into electrical signals your devices can use. It is typically installed near your electrical panel or another convenient indoor location. The ONT must be powered via an electrical outlet, and in some cases, a backup UPS or surge protector is recommended to maintain connectivity during power outages.

Step 4: Connect the ONT to Your RouterUse a Cat6 Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to your router or gateway. If your ISP provides a combo unit, the ONT and router may be integrated into a single device. For larger homes, you may add mesh Wi-Fi devices to extend coverage.

Step 5: Test and Activate the ConnectionOnce the ONT and router are connected, the technician will power on the devices, test the fiber connection, and confirm that your internet speed and signal quality meet the expected performance. They will also ensure that Wi-Fi coverage is optimized and that all devices can connect successfully.
