

How to connect the fiber optic cable drop box

If the box has splice trays, place the fiber in the bottom tray for splicing and the top tray for drop cable connections. Ensure the fiber is routed neatly to prevent interference or damage.

Step 4: Terminate the Fiber Connect the fiber to the adapter panel or splice-on connectors. For pre-terminated cables, plug the connectors directly into the SC or LC adapters. For bare fibers, perform mechanical or fusion splicing to connect the drop cable to pigtails or splitters inside the box. Make sure each port corresponds correctly to the intended connection.

Step 5: Connect to the ONT Run the fiber from the drop box to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) inside or outside the home. The ONT converts the optical signal into electrical signals for your router or gateway. C...
