

How to connect to the internet from the splitter

An internet splitter allows you to connect multiple devices to a single network cable, but it may reduce speed depending on the type and setup. Types of Internet Splitters

1. Ethernet Cable Splitters: These devices divide one Ethernet cable into two connections, allowing two devices to share a single cable. They work by splitting the internal wires of a CAT5e or CAT6 cable into separate channels. Standard splitters typically convert a single 1000 Mbps cable into two 100 Mbps connections, so speed may be limited compared to the original cable. They are plug-and-play and compatible with computers, printers, smart TVs, routers, and switches.
2. PoE (Power over Ethernet) Splitters: These splitters separate data and power from a PoE cable, providing a standard Ethernet connection and a DC power output for devices that do not support PoE. This is useful for IP cameras or access points without local power adapters.
3. DSL/Phone Line Splitters: For DSL internet, a splitter separates the phone line from the internet signal, allowing simultaneous use of the phone and internet without interference. These are different from Ethernet splitters and are specific to DSL connections.

Key Considerations

- Speed Limitations: Standard Ethernet splitters may reduce the maximum speed per device. For full gigabit speeds, a network switch is often a better solution.
- Compatibility: Ensure the splitter supports your cable type (CAT5e, CAT6, or CAT8) and network speed requirements.
- Installation: Most splitters are simple plug-and-play, but some setups may require paired splitters at both ends of the cable to function correctly.
- Durability: High-quality splitters use gold-plated connectors and metal shielding to ensure reliable connections and reduce interference.

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A: To connect and use an Ethernet splitter cable, insert its single end into the Ethernet port on your modem or router, then take both of its output ports and attach them to your devices
