

How to correctly install a secondary distribution box

Wire Preparation: Strip insulation from wires to the correct length, ensuring exposed conductors are neither too long nor too short .

Circuit Breaker Installation: Install breakers according to the load requirements of each branch circuit .

Termination and Wiring: Connect line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground following color coding standards. Secure wires to terminals using screws or wire strippers, and route wires neatly with cable ties, leaving space for heat dissipation .

Labeling: Clearly mark each circuit for easy identification and future maintenance .
