If a connected PoE device powers on and the LED illuminates, it confirms the port is PoE-enabled. If the LED remains off, the port may be non-PoE or the connected device does not require power.
4. Use the Switch's Management Interface Managed PoE switches often provide a web or admin interface where you can check PoE settings, power allocation, and port status. If the interface shows PoE options, the switch supports power delivery.
5. Test with a PoE Device Plug a known PoE device, such as an IP camera or VoIP phone, into the switch. If the device powers on without an external power supply, the port is PoE-enabled. This is a practical way to confirm functionality.
6. Multimeter Testing (Advanced) For technical verification, a multimeter can measure voltage on the Ethernet pins. Standard PoE delivers around 48V, but this method is less common and should be done carefully to avoid damaging the switch or device.
