Select Distribution list and click Next. Enter a Group Name and optional description. Assign an email address for the group. Select members who should receive emails. Click Create group to finalize. Using Exchange Admin Center (EAC) Open the Exchange Admin Center. Go to Recipients → Groups → Add a group. Choose Distribution as the group type and click Next. Configure the group name, description, and email address. Assign at least one owner who can manage members. Add initial members and complete the setup. Managing Members and Owners Owners can add or remove members, approve requests, and manage messages sent to the group. Members can be added or removed via the EAC or Outlook if you are assigned as an owner. For dynamic groups, membership rules determine who receives emails automatically. Best Practices Assign at least one owner to each group to ensure proper management. Use descriptive names for groups to make them easily identifiable. Consider dynamic groups for larg...
