4. **Curtains or Fabric Covers** Install a curtain or fabric panel in front of the box. This is a quick, flexible solution that can blend with your interior design and be pulled aside when needed.
5. **DIY Covers and Medallions** Create a custom wooden or plastic cover, or adapt ceiling medallions and canopies for junction boxes. Ensure the cover is removable and does not obstruct ventilation or wiring.
6. **Functional Disguises** Use standing mirrors, bulletin boards, or even decorative shelving to hide the box while adding functionality to the space.
