Never open the cover while the power is on (). Protect the joint surfaces from scratches and apply anti-rust oil after maintenance (). Use rain covers for outdoor installations to prevent water ingress and corrosion ().

Removal and Maintenance

Power Off: Always disconnect the main power supply before removing the box ().

Disconnect Wiring: Carefully loosen and remove all cable connections, ensuring grounding wires are safely detached ().

Inspect Components: Check for damage, corrosion, or wear before reinstalling or disposing of the box ().
