

How to lay wires in electrical cable trays

Secure cables at intervals recommended by the manufacturer, typically every 1.5–2 meters, to prevent sagging.

Grounding and Bonding For metal trays, ensure proper grounding and bonding. Use bonding jumpers across tray sections to maintain electrical continuity, and verify that the tray can serve as an Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) if required.

Labeling and Documentation Label all cables clearly for identification and maintenance purposes. Maintain an updated wiring map to facilitate troubleshooting and future upgrades.

Final Checks and Maintenance Perform a thorough inspection to check for loose clamps, misaligned trays, overfilled sections, or unsupported spans. Conduct routine maintenance to look for corrosion, damaged insulation, or broken supports, ensuring...
