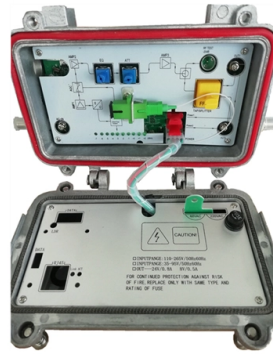


How to make cable trays in wire troughs
