

How to properly route the router's fiber optic cable

- Clean connectors:** Remove dust caps and handle connectors by the plastic housing to prevent contamination.
- ONT placement:** Position the ONT within 3 meters of the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss. Ensure it is in a dry, ventilated area near a power outlet.
- Connect fiber to ONT:** Align the connector key and gently push until it clicks securely.

- Ethernet link:** Use a high-quality Cat6a or higher Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port.
- Router placement:** Place the router centrally in your home, elevated if possible, and away from obstructions or heat sources to optimize Wi-Fi coverage.
- Power sequence:** Power on the ONT first, wait for status lights to stabilize, then power on the router.

Configuration Tips

- Access the router's admin panel (usually 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to configure WAN settings according to your ISP (PPPoE, DHCP, or static IP).
- Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if using VoIP or video conferencing to prioritize critical traffic.
- Keep the fiber cable area clean and well-lit during installation to prevent...
