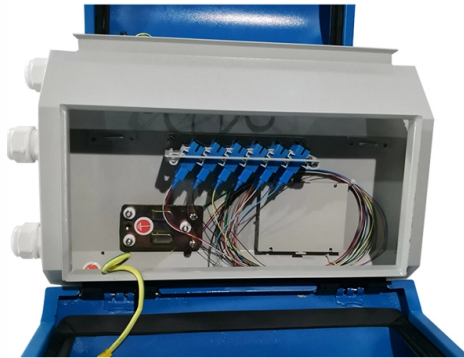


How to repair rust on galvanized cable trays

In workshop settings, thermal zinc spraying or using a zinc alloy rod with a blowtorch can provide a durable repair, though care must be taken to avoid overheating surrounding areas.

Step 4: Apply a Protective Topcoat After zinc restoration, consider applying a metal-protective topcoat or paint compatible with galvanized steel to seal the surface and prevent future corrosion. This is especially important in harsh environments with high humidity, coastal air, or chemical exposure.
