

How to repeat a gigabit fiber optic router

6. Test the Connection After setup, test the connection by checking the internet speed and coverage in areas previously out of range. Make adjustments to placement or settings if necessary to optimize performance .

- Placement Matters:** Position the repeater router within a strong signal range of the main router to avoid speed degradation .

- Check Compatibility:** Ensure your router is “fiber-ready” and supports the necessary VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE settings required by your...
